

## Notice on Foreign Student Scholarship Application (Spring 2024)

### 1. Eligibility

- Foreign graduate school students who will register for their regular semester in the Spring 2024.
  - \* Students who will register for their additional semester for credit earning, research semester or who will supposed to have a leave of absence as of 2024 spring semester **are not eligible**.
  - \* GKS scholars and joint/dual degree students **are not eligible**.
- All requirements(please refer to the '2. Requirements') for application should be met.
- Students should apply for the scholarship every semester.

- **Requirement I: GPA for 2023 Fall semester (To be announced in January 2024)**
  - \* If GPA doesn't meet the requirements, the application will be cancelled automatically.
  - \* The GPA is not confirmed as of the application period, students can apply one or more type scholarships.(However, the students can receive only one type of scholarships.)
- **Requirement II: Completion of Compulsory Education for Foreign Students**  
 (①Sexual Violence Prevention Education and ②Understanding Korean Laws and Regulations Education)
  - \* From Fall 2023, only those students who already complete to take compulsory courses can apply for the scholarships.
  - \* Please check the attatched files for how-to sign up the courses and how-to get a certificate of completion.

- **Application Period:** 1<sup>st</sup> December(Fri) - 31<sup>st</sup> December(Sun), 2023

  - ① Application form and Statement of ability for an applicant
  - ② Certificate of completion for each Compulsory Education for Foreign Students
